LOVE THE STRANGER

Scripture tells us: "Love the stranger then, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt" (Deuteronomy 10;19)
People making dangerous journeys across the Channel to reach the UK are also called by various names: 'refugees', 'asylum seekers', 'migrants', and often by more derogatory terms.

"Love the Stranger", a document released in March this year by the Bishops of England and Wales, articulates our Christian duty to look beyond such labels and recognise 'that trafficking and slavery are exacerbated by a lack of accessible alternatives for migration and seeking sanctuary'. The booklet is a remarkably radical statement of Catholic Social Teaching on refugees and migrants that all Catholics should know about.

DSEI -12-15 September 2023 - Excel London

DSEI (Defence and Security Equipment International) is one of the world's largest arms fairs. It takes place in London Docklands every two years bringing together governments and military delegations from across the world with more than 1,500 companies selling guns, bombs and other weaponry. In 2021 the Catholic Bishops from across the UK took up the call of Pope Francis to end the arms trade. They signed a statement that emphasised "how conflicts fuelled by the trade harm the world's poorest communities with devastating consequences for our environment". And they recall the Pope's message that arms are sold simply for money, "money that is drenched in blood, often innocent blood. In face of this shameful and culpable silence, it is our duty to confront the problem and to stop the arms trade."
